### Use of Rodmell Sports Field and/or Cricket Pavilion for private functions

- ⤴ Day to day maintenance of the Cricket Pavilion last year cost almost £700 and Sports Field £850. These figures exclude insurance and any major refurbishment projects
- ⤴ We are extremely fortunate to also benefit from the unpaid work of volunteers who regularly do DIY jobs, remove rubbish, cut hedges and do additional mowing/strimming etc.
- ⤴ To book the venue for private functions but to help offset our growing costs the revised charges are: -
  - ⤴ Weddings, children's, and family parties £250, including a non-returnable advance deposit of £100
  - ⤴ camp outs £50, paid in advance, and a returnable £50 deposit in advance to cover possible damage or the site being left in an unsatisfactory condition.
  - ⤴ combined weddings/parties and camp outs £300, including a non-returnable advance deposit of £100
  - ⤴ **25% discount on all bookings for residents.**

Bookings, which should be made through the Parish Clerk, are taken on the understanding that:

- ⤴ No smoking is permitted in the Cricket Pavilion
- ⤴ Users should be considerate of other residents. Bookings are made on the understanding that all **amplified music should cease by midnight, and your guests should be asked** to leave quietly as they exit the village.
- ⤴ Whilst there are rubbish bins on the site, there is no rubbish collection by the District Council. Please therefore take your rubbish home with you and leave the venue as you found it.
- ⤴ Please lock up carefully and return all keys promptly.
- ⤴ Please note the site is rural, the field is inevitably rough and uneven and lighting is limited. Please take the appropriate precautions to avoid accidents.
